ge cannot confine a true artist, especially those rare gems like Erika Binns.

Binns calls herself a "late bloomer". She didn't touch a canvas until well into retirement. A flickering interest borne from boredom became a passion as she learned pastel painting at her local senior center. As her feverish hands smudged ochres, crimson and blues, an artist emerged.
